Finally programming keys (into the engines ECU) to get the car started!!!

All courses take place at our dedicated training workshop in Birmingham. During the course we provide each candidate with all the necessary tools, manuals and a business plan to enable YOU to successfully start & run an automotive locksmith business. Automotive locksmithing is not a 'cheap' business to start up in, however we will help you to focus on specific areas in the beginning to reduce your start-up costs as well as help you to focus your learning to ensure a solid technical expertise.

The lifestyle and earning potential for an automotive locksmith is very lucrative due to the limited number of automotive locksmiths (due to the barriers to this trade i.e. start-up costs and technical 'know-how'), as well as the vaster customer base compared to general locksmithing.

Example:- A standard call out for lost car keys which need replacing and programming is anywhere between £180 and £350 depending on time of day and make, year and model of the vehicle. Time to complete such a job can vary but is approximately 1 hour.

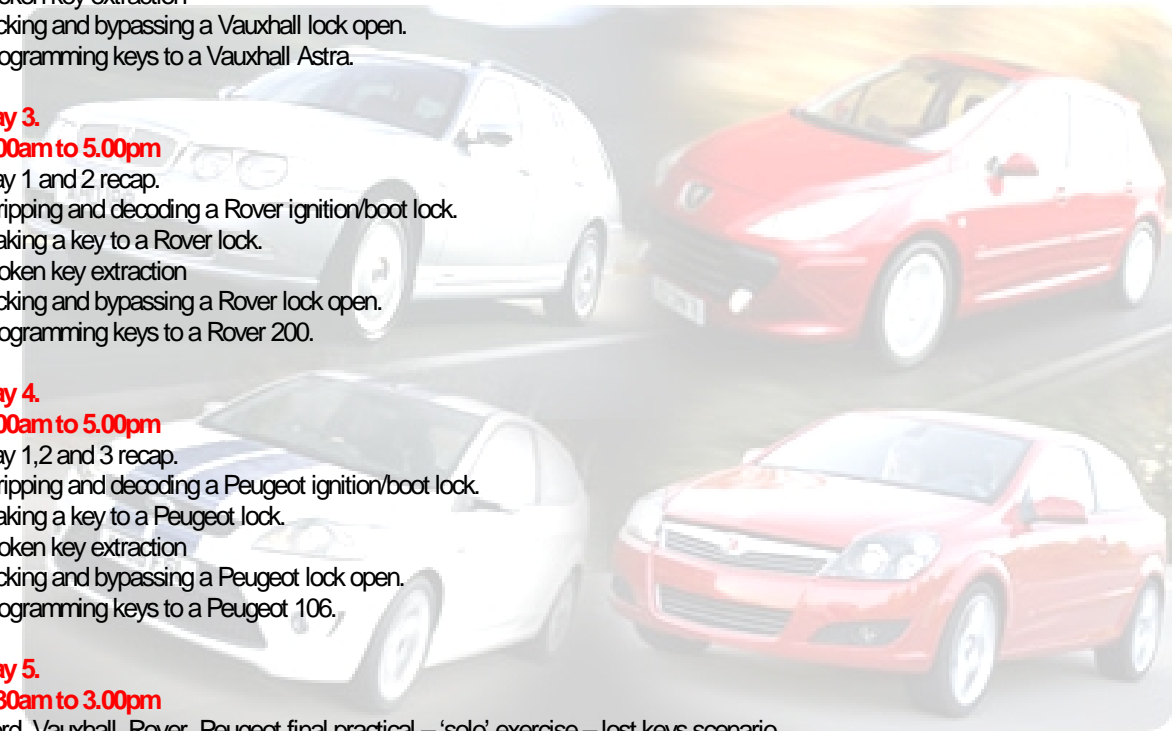
